Well, haven't things changed in twenty years?! I think, for now, we'd better start preparing for the future!!



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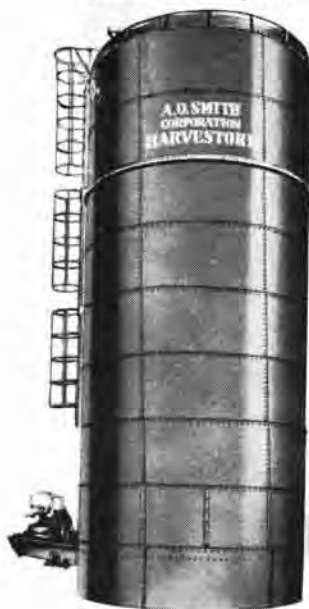


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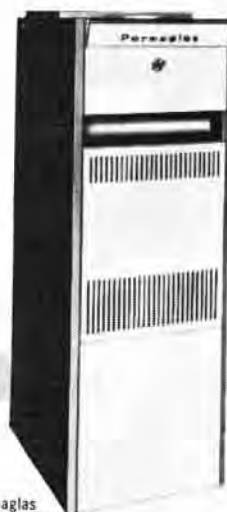
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
